Shannon Cochrane is a Canadian performance artist, curator and writer. Her performance work has been presented in museums, galleries, festivals and in all kinds of events across Canada and internationally in 25 countries. Over the last 25 years, Shannon has contributed to the development of the Canadian performance art ecology through curating, programming, producing, advocating and supporting performance artists and their work. She is a founding member of Toronto's 7A*11D International Festival of Performance Art, and from 1996–2022 co-curated and organized 14 international performance festivals with the collective. As the current Director of FADO Performance Art since 2007, she has curated and produced the work of hundreds of performance artists from around the world for Toronto audiences. She has written about performance art as a discipline, form and practice for print, online and various platforms/projects.
